Applicant: #7 Proof of college/university or vocation/technical school acceptance or enrollment, including contact information. If in college/university or vocation/technical school, provide official transcript showing upcoming fall classes. Proof should show college/university or vocation/technical school name and address.

The Scholarship Committee realizes Applicant may have more than seven pages total, but numbering pages ensures the application is complete. Number only those pages outlined above, not every page. Incomplete applications may not be reviewed and may have a lower score. Completed applications must be **postmarked no later than July 1** of the current year.
